RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The conference schedule must be followed by everyone.**
- Attendance at all meetings (including cabin times and morning revival) is mandatory. In case of sickness, appropriate medical attention will be obtained and parents may be asked to come take the sick child home.
- During cabin times, everyone will be encouraged to participate.
- No one may leave the camp grounds at any time.
- No electronic items are allowed (radios, TV, cassette players, CD players, games, etc.)
Cell phones are for emergency use only, and will be turned off during all meetings and sleep/rest times.
- No novels or magazines are permitted, only spiritual reading materials or homework. This includes the rides to and from the camp. Homework material may **not** include novels or other types of fiction.
- Brothers are not permitted in the areas of the sisters' lodging, and sisters are not permitted in the areas the brothers are occupying.
- All clothing worn during the entire weekend must be proper and modest. **No sleeveless, low cut, skin-tight or skin-revealing shirts may be worn. No shorts, pants that sag, hip-hugger or low rise pants may be worn. No clothing, caps, or shirts with improper pictures, logos, or symbols may be worn. This applies to brothers and sisters.** [Please read: Watchman Nee, *Messages for Building Up New Believers*, vol. 3, chapter 37].
- All **Camp Regulations** must be observed. For example, no alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, firearms, knives, illegal drugs, flammable liquids, explosives, poisonous substances, or cliff climbing are permitted at the camp. **Fighting** – All forms of physical violence are expressly forbidden and are grounds for immediate expulsion of the offending parties and possible criminal charges being filed. **Profanity / Vulgar Speech** – will not be tolerated at any time
- Snacks and food are to be kept out of the bedrooms.
- Due to fire danger, candle usage will not be allowed in any building.
- All attendees must follow the instructions of the serving ones.**

Christ as Jesus and Emmanuel

Matthew 1:20–21 But while he pondered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife, for that which has been begotten in her is of the Holy Spirit. **21** And she will bear a son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for it is He who will save His people from their sins.

Exodus 3:14 And God said to Moses, I AM WHO I AM. And He said, Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, I AM has sent me to you.

Joshua 1:1–2 After the death of Moses the servant of Jehovah, Jehovah spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' attendant, saying, **2** Moses My servant is dead; now then arise, and cross over this Jordan, you and all this people, into the land which I am giving to them, to the children of Israel.

Deuteronomy 12:9 For until now you have not come to the rest and to the inheritance that Jehovah your God is giving you.

Hebrews 4:8 For if Joshua had brought them into rest, He would not have spoken concerning another day after these things.

Matthew 11:28–29 Come to Me all who toil and are burdened, and I will give you rest. **29** Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am meek and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Matthew 5:2 And opening His mouth, He taught them, saying,

Matthew 7:28 And when Jesus finished these words, the crowds were astounded at His teaching

Matthew 7:29 For He taught them as One having authority and not like their scribes.

Matthew 5:3 Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of the heavens.

Matthew 5:6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

Matthew 5:10 Blessed are those who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of the heavens.

Matthew 5:20 For I say to you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you shall by no means enter into the kingdom of the heavens.

Matthew 5:48 You therefore shall be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect.

Matthew 6:1 But take care not to do your righteousness before men in order to be gazed at by them; otherwise, you have no reward with your Father who is in the heavens.

Matthew 6:31 Therefore do not be anxious, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, With what shall we be clothed?

Matthew 6:32 For all these things the Gentiles are anxiously seeking. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.

Matthew 6:33 But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

Matthew 14:19 And after commanding the crowds to recline on the grass, He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke the loaves and gave *them* to the disciples, and the disciples to the crowds.

Matthew 14:20 And they all ate and were satisfied. And they took up what was left over of the broken pieces, twelve handbaskets full.

Matthew 15:26 But He answered and said, It is not good to take the children's bread and throw *it* to the little dogs.

Matthew 15:27 And she said, Yes, Lord, for even the little dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table.

Message Three

Christ as the Most Pleasant Person

Matthew 8:2–3 And behold, a leper, coming near, worshipped Him, saying, Lord, if You are willing, You can cleanse me. **3** And stretching out His hand, He touched him, saying, I am willing; be cleansed! And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Matthew 8:5–9, 13 And when He entered into Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, beseeching Him **6** And saying, Lord, my servant is lying in the house paralyzed, terribly tormented. **7** And He said to him, I will come and heal him. **8** But the centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not fit for You to enter under my roof; but only speak a word, and my servant will be healed. **9** For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this one, Go, and he goes; and to another, Come, and he comes; and to my slave, Do this, and he does it.... **13** And Jesus said to the centurion, Go. As you have believed, so be it done to you. And his servant was healed in that hour.

Matthew 8:14–15 And Jesus, coming into Peter's house, saw his mother-in-law lying down and in a fever. **15** And He touched her hand, and the fever left her. And she arose and served Him.

Matthew 8:16 And when evening fell, they brought to Him many who were demon possessed, and He cast out the spirits with a word, and all those who were ill He healed,

Matthew 9:6–7 But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins--then He said to the paralytic, Rise, take up your bed and go to your house. **7** And he rose and went away to his house.

Matthew 9:10–12 And as He was reclining at table in the house, behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and reclined together with Jesus and His disciples. **11** And when the Pharisees saw it, they said to His disciples, Why does your Teacher eat with the tax collectors and sinners? **12** Now when He heard this, He said, Those who are strong have no need of a physician, but those who are ill.

Matthew 9:14–17 Then the disciples of John came to Him, saying, Why do we and the Pharisees fast much, but Your disciples do not fast? **15** And Jesus said to them, The sons of the bridechamber cannot mourn as long as the Bridegroom is with them, can they? But days will come when the Bridegroom will be taken away from

them, and then they will fast. **16** No one puts a patch of unfulled cloth on an old garment, for that which fills it up pulls away from the garment, and a worse tear is made. **17** Neither do they put new wine into old wineskins; otherwise, the wineskins burst, and the wine pours out, and the wineskins are ruined; but they put new wine into fresh wineskins, and both are preserved.

Matthew 9:27–30a And as Jesus passed on from there, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, Have mercy on us, Son of David! **28** And when He came into the house, the blind men came to Him; and Jesus said to them, Do you believe that I am able to do this? They said to Him, Yes, Lord. **29** Then He touched their eyes, saying, According to your faith, let it be done to you. **30** And their eyes were opened....

Matthew 9:32–33 And as they were going out, behold, they brought to Him a dumb man possessed with a demon. **33** And when the demon was cast out, the dumb man spoke. And the crowds marveled, saying, Never has anything like this been seen in Israel.

Matthew 9:35 And Jesus went about all the cities and the villages, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every sickness.

Christ as the Sower and Seed

Matthew 13:3 And He spoke many things to them in parables, saying, Behold, the sower went out to sow.

Matthew 13:4 And as he sowed, some seeds fell beside the way, and the birds came and devoured them.

Matthew 13:5 And others fell on the rocky places, where they did not have much earth, and immediately they sprang up because they had no depth of earth.

Matthew 13:6 But when the sun rose, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered.

Matthew 13:7 And others fell on the thorns, and the thorns came up and choked them.

Matthew 13:8 But others fell on the good earth and yielded fruit, one a hundredfold, and one sixtyfold, and one thirtyfold.

Christ as King and Lord

Matthew 1:1 The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

Matthew 12:40–42 For just as Jonah was in the belly of the great fish three days and three nights, so will the Son of Man be in the heart of the earth three days and three nights. **41** Ninevite men will stand up in the judgment with this generation and will condemn it, because they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and behold, something more than Jonah is here. **42** The queen of the south will rise up in the judgment with this generation and will condemn it, because she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon, and behold, something more than Solomon is here.

Matthew 16:15–19 He said to them, But you, who do you say that I am? **16** And Simon Peter answered and said, You are the Christ, the Son of the living God. **17** And Jesus answered and said to him, Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in the heavens. **18** And I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. **19** I will give to you the keys of the kingdom of the heavens, and whatever you bind on the earth shall have been bound in the heavens, and whatever you loose on the earth shall have been loosed in the heavens.

Matthew 28:18–20 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. **19** Go therefore and disciple all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **20** Teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you all the days until the consummation of the age.
